- Uphold a high standard of ethical and professional behaviour (i.e. deal with confidential information appropriately, understand boundaries, make ethical decisions, treat clients and colleagues with dignity and respect etc.)
- Have an understanding childhood development
- Appreciate the impact that they have on our students each day
- Positively contribute to our work culture at Aspire Academy
- Are willing to self-reflect, accept feedback and be vulnerable in an open workplace
- Actively participate in professional development activities
